

Adoption Statement Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 Sefton Council

Control of Betting Shops and Hot Food Takeaways Supplementary Planning Document

In accordance with Regulations 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is given that Sefton Council adopted the Control of Betting Shops and Hot Food Takeaways Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 7th September 2017.

The Control of Betting Shops and Hot Food Takeaways SPD expands upon policies EQ1 'Healthy Sefton' and EQ10 'Food and Drink' in the Sefton Local Plan (2017).

The SPD will be used to inform decisions on land use planning in Sefton.

The proposals came into operation on 7th September 2017. Any person aggrieved by the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Such an application must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
